Job description

The laboratory assistant supports activities related to research and is responsible for the operation and maintenance of laboratory equipment and supplies.

Familiarity with experimental economics, or economics in general, is not required. Extensive training will be provided for each of the responsibilities listed below.

Location: University of Vienna, the experiments take place at the Campus (Court 1)

Hours: flexible with a minimum of 10 hours per month Pay: 11.7 € per hour

Responsabilities

- » Operating laboratory computers
- » Assisting in the logistics and coordination of experiments
- » Keeping the lab tidy
- Interacting with human participants
- Demonstrating and/or explaining of proper laboratory procedures
- Working with researchers and other assistants
- » Performing administrative duties as required

Requirements

- » Interest in economic research
- » English; German is not required but is an asset
- » Third-country nationals are not eligible
